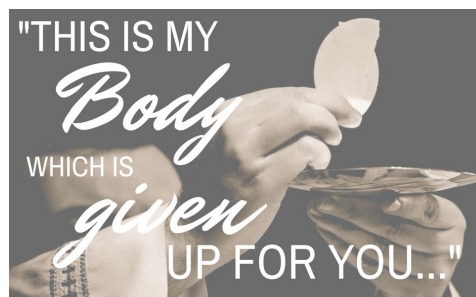
"Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them and they all drank from it." – MARK 14:23

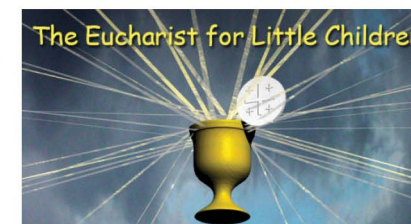
