What is "First Friday" Devotion? First Friday Devotion is an observance and honor to the Sacred Heart of Jesus based on promises made by our Lord to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. This devotion consists of 1) Attending Mass on the 1st Friday of the Month for nine consecutive

months 2) Confession (at least 8 days before/after 1st Friday). Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary promises to those who kept this devotion of his love through His Sacred Heart. The 12 promises are: (1) He will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life. (2) He will establish peace in their homes. (3) He will comfort them in all their afflictions. (4) He will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death. (5) He will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings. (6) Sinners will find in His Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy. (7) Lukewarm souls shall become fervent. (8) Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection. (9) He will bless every place in which an image of His Heart is exposed and honored. (10) He will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts. (11) Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in His Heart. (12) In the excessive mercy of His Heart that His all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in His disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. His divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.
