**LENTEN WEEK 6 : A SEGREGATED BUT NOT SEPARATE** Once, not so long ago, rich and poor worshipped together in the same parish. However, with the advent of automobiles and suburbs, our parishes have become economically segregated. So now for many of us, when Jesus talks about the poor, it is hard to think of someone we actually know. Stereotypes fill the void, and tempt us to think they have brought it on themselves through addiction or bad choices. If we are not careful we can take Jesus’ admonition “For you always have the poor with you, but you will not always have me” (Mathew 26:11) as a way out. **Marriage Minute** “Holy Week for Marriage” Praise, temptation to despair, indignant questioning from one who does not understand his mission, rejection, and eventually, death.
