



## GOSPEL FAMILY CONNECTION

Mark 10:35-45 (shorter form Mark 10:42-45): Jesus teaches that those who wish to be great must be the servant of all. Jesus explains the importance of service and sacrifice in the life of a disciple.

- **1-3 grade:** Being a helper is a way to show that we care for others, just as Jesus cares for us. Jesus calls helpers “servants.” What are some ways that you have helped your friends and family? (Accept all reasonable responses.) How might we serve people in need in our community? (Go with our parents to volunteer at a fund-raiser or visit an elderly parishioner, donate clothes, etc.)
- **4-6 grade:** In the words that follow, Jesus teaches his disciples what it will take to be great in the Kingdom of God. What does Jesus say? (that those who wish to be first in God’s kingdom must be the servants of others)
- **7-8 grade:** What is the symbol of the honor that James and John seek? (a seat at Jesus’ side when he comes in glory) What does Jesus say will be required of the people who will receive such an honor? (to suffer in the same way that Jesus will suffer) What is Jesus’ answer to James and John? (that Jesus cannot give them the honor they seek)
- **Family life:** Talk about ways in which you might apply Jesus’ words in your family life. Conclude by praying we may receive honor in God’s eyes by learning to serve others in love. Pray together the Peace Prayer of Saint Francis.
