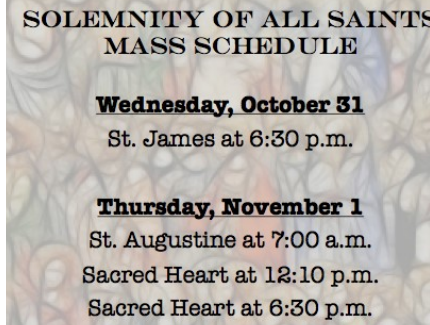
NEW 24 ADORATION SIGN UP!
