The idea was formed by seminarians who wanted to accomplish 2 things: offer a low cost mission trip experience and provide service to the people in their own communities. They chose to name their program after a quote about Mary from St. Pope John Paul II that emphasized Mary's dedication to both prayer AND action. The program will reach out to various communities of our host parish, providing for those most in need. This is done by the laboring hands and the open hearts of high school students and their adult leaders. The most important aspect of Prayer & Action is the evangelization and inspiration of the youth, which is the fruit of their prayer and labor.
