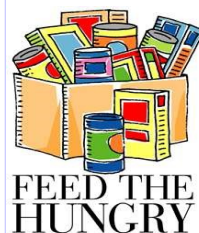
SUMMER VACATION

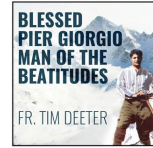
Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati
