MARRIAGE MINUTE

Do you want the angels to rejoice? Scripture tells us that it is simple to make the angels rejoice. All we have to do is repent of sin. It may be simple, but that does not make it easy. We can think that the angels rejoice when big public sinners repent, but remember, the angels do not put a qualifier on the “bigness” of the sin. Turning away from sin, no matter how big, causes rejoicing in heaven.

Examination for Married Couples:

- Do I spend time with my spouse?
- Have I been affectionate with my spouse?
 - Have I listened to my spouse?
 - Have I prayed with my spouse?
- Am I attentive to my spouse's needs?
- Have I spoken harshly to my spouse?
- Have I been moody with my spouse?

VIRTUS TRAINING: PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

All volunteers who have contact with children and/or youth are required to submit background checks prior to working with children or teens. All volunteers, staff, clergy **whose role puts them in contact with children/youth are required to attend a child safety awareness program designed for adults called Virtus**. Volunteers between the ages of 16-18 who participate in environments and activities that may include other children will also be required to attend a Virtus awareness session. The purpose of these awareness sessions is to educate ourselves as caring adult members of our parish community to create and sustain a safe environment for our children and youth. All CCD teachers, volunteers and parents who wish to be involved as teachers, volunteers, host families, chaperones, drivers to youth events, etc. are strongly encouraged to attend a Virtus awareness session in order to participate in these roles. Even if you are not currently serving in any volunteer capacity with our youth ministries yet, *please consider attending*. We will host a Virtus Awareness Session on **Tuesday, September 24 at 6:00pm** in the parish hall at Sacred Heart.
