VIRTUS TRAINING: Protecting God's Children – All volunteers who have contact with children and/or youth are required to submit background checks prior to working with children or teens. The purpose of these awareness sessions is to educate ourselves as caring adult members of our parish community to create and sustain a safe environment for our children and youth. All CCD teachers, volunteers and parents who wish to be involved as teachers, volunteers, host families, chaperones, drivers to youth events, etc. are strongly encouraged to attend a Virtus awareness session in order to participate in these roles.
